

#### Page 12 Updates

**Event Verification** - Describe how inspections verify the RTA confirms the successful repair of an <u>event</u> scene.

- Policies and procedures should address the inspection of areas with similar characteristics to those where an <u>event</u> occurred.
- o Post-event repair inspections verify that the RFGPTS successfully repaired the event scene.
- Beyond confirming the repairs, the policies and procedures should include how the SSOA will assess whether the RTA is leveraging data and information collected through investigation activity to determine probable cause and to support the identification of hazards.

The RBI Toolkit will be updated by January 2024.

## **RBI Development Plan: ASP Submission**

- RTAs must update their Agency Safety Plan (ASP) to include policies and procedures for:
  - Providing SSOAs with access to the RTA to conduct RBIs (Category 2)
  - Sharing with the SSOA, the data the RTA collects when identifying hazards and assessing and mitigating safety risk (Category 3)
- To streamline the ASP update process, some SSOAs have asked:
  - If the RTA can submit proposed language for the ASP, and
  - Wait until after FTA approves the RBI development plan to incorporate the language into the ASP
- Why?
  - To avoid potentially updating their ASP twice
  - Timing for required annual ASP updates may not align with RBI plan submission deadline

## RBI Development Plan: ASP Submission (continued)

SSOA submits proposed ASP language related to RBI requirements. Submission includes:

a. Full ASP, citing pages/sections that address RBI requirements



b. Section of the ASP that addresses RBI requirements



c. Program Standard that cites where language related to each requirement appears in the submitted ASP



# Category 5: RBI Programs are Commensurate with Number, Size and Complexity of RFGPTS the SSOA Oversees (continued)

# Submit SSOA Program Standard policies and procedures that demonstrate the SSOA inspects the full spectrum of activities for each RTA it oversees and that those inspections are prioritized based on relevant data, including safety program, maintenance, and inspection data collected by the SSOAs.

#### **Considerations**

Does your Program Standard include policies and procedures that demonstrate the SSOA inspects the <u>full spectrum of activities</u> for each RTA it oversees?

Inspected activities must include at a minimum:

- Scheduling inspections
- Inspection reports
- Immediate safety concerns
- Inspections of equipment, infrastructure, and practices specific to each RFGPTS
- Event verification
- Ongoing monitoring (procedures, maintenance, and operations)
- Defects and corrective or remedial action
- CAP and safety risk mitigation verification

Submit an <u>updated workload</u> <u>assessment</u> to align with increased <u>responsibilities</u> of the risk-based	☐ Did you submit an updated workload assessment that includes increased responsibilities for risk-based inspection activities?
inspection program.	<ul> <li>Does your workload assessment describe the activities and resources that the SSOA will require to perform risk-based inspections?</li> <li>Examples of activities: data analysis, risk assessment, track, power, signals, vehicles, operations, and communications.</li> </ul>

# Category 6: SSO Staffing, Qualifications, and Training (continued)

SSOA Required Actions (D0016)	Considerations
Submit documentation that confirms the qualifications and capability of SSOA personnel conducting risk-based inspections in required areas of expertise.	Did you submit an updated Technical Training Plan (TTP) that confirms SSOA personnel conducting risk-based inspections are qualified and skilled in the competencies needed to fulfill RBI program requirements such as data analysis, risk assessment, and inspection?

# Category 6: SSO Staffing, Qualifications, and Training (continued)

SSOA Required Actions (D0017) Co	onsiderations
Training Plan to align with the	<ul> <li>Did the SSOA submit an updated Technical Training Plan (TTP) to align with any changes to the SSOA's oversight responsibilities, including those related to a risk-based inspection program?</li> <li>Does the updated TTP reflect personnel and necessary training for each activity outlined in the SSOA's workload assessment?</li> <li>Does the TTP include any training required by the RTA to access specific areas of the system, such as Roadway Worker Protection training?</li> </ul>
