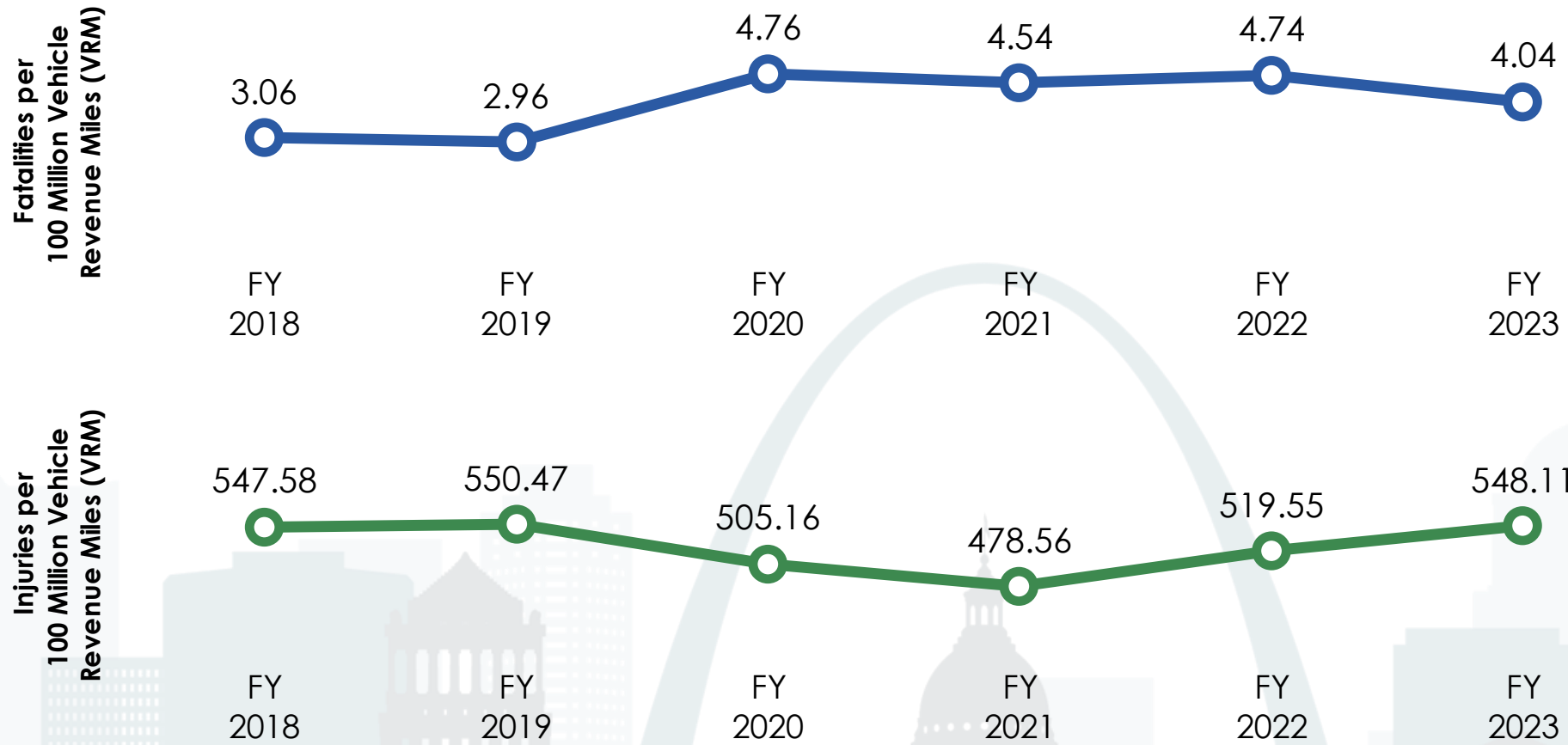

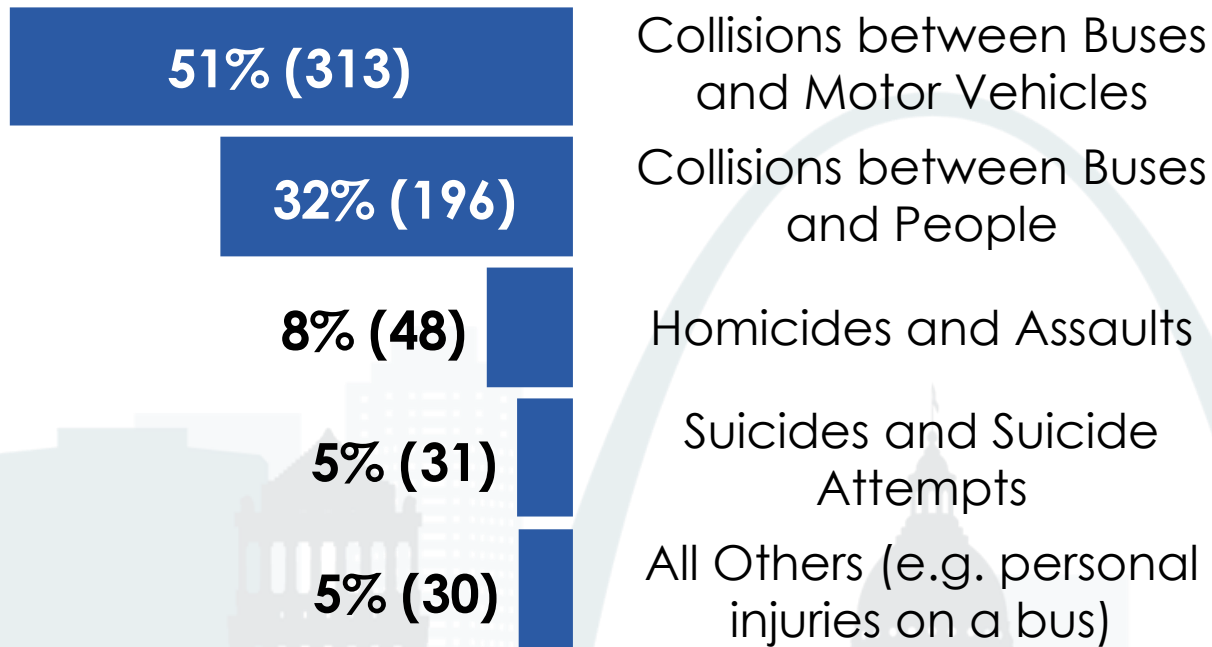

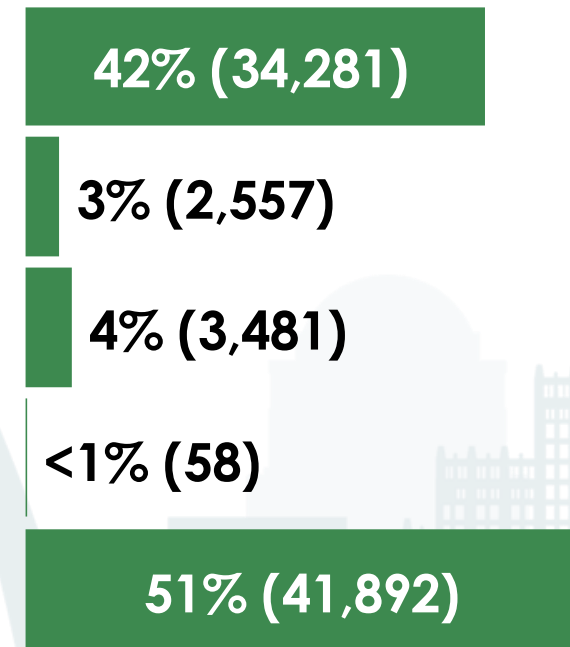

Fatalities



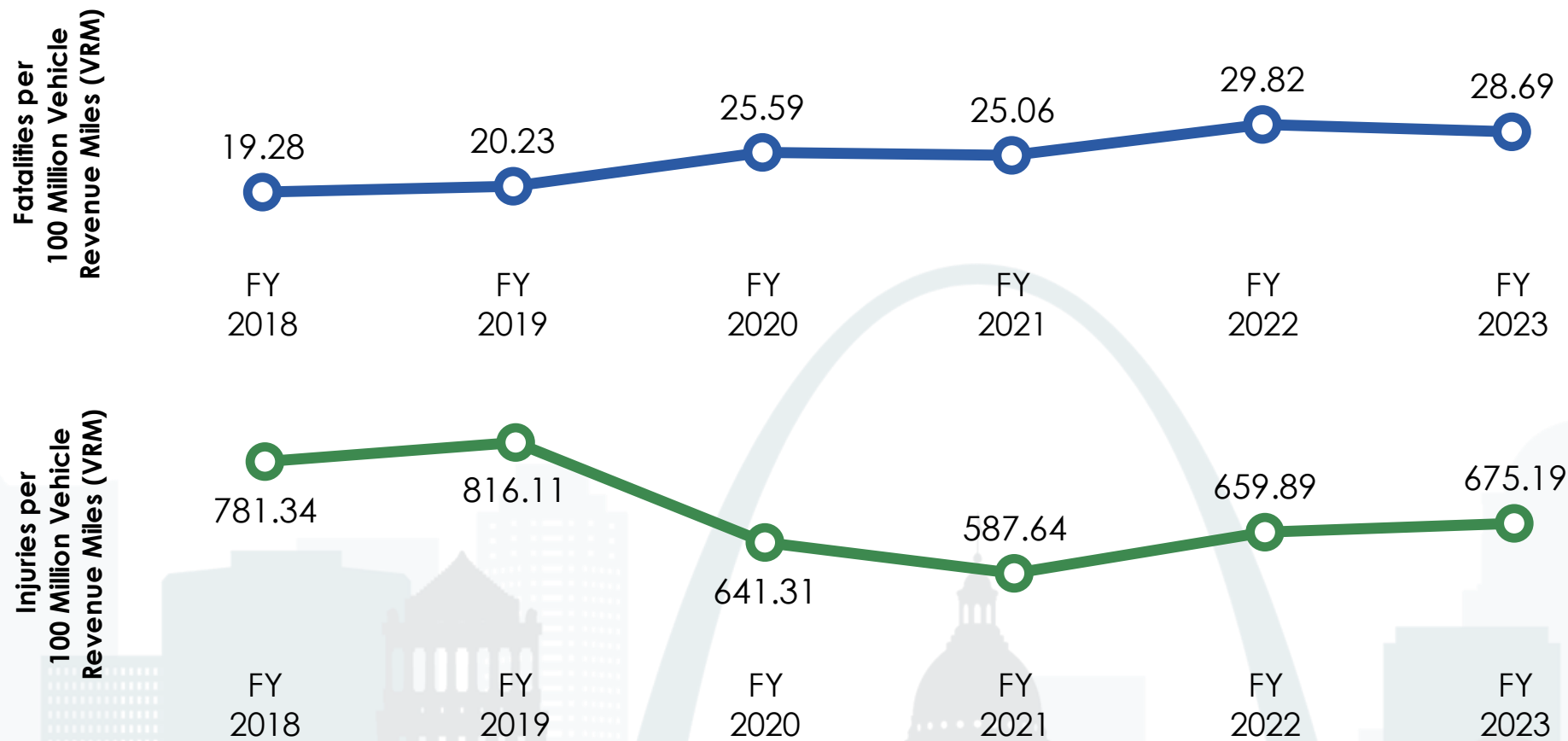

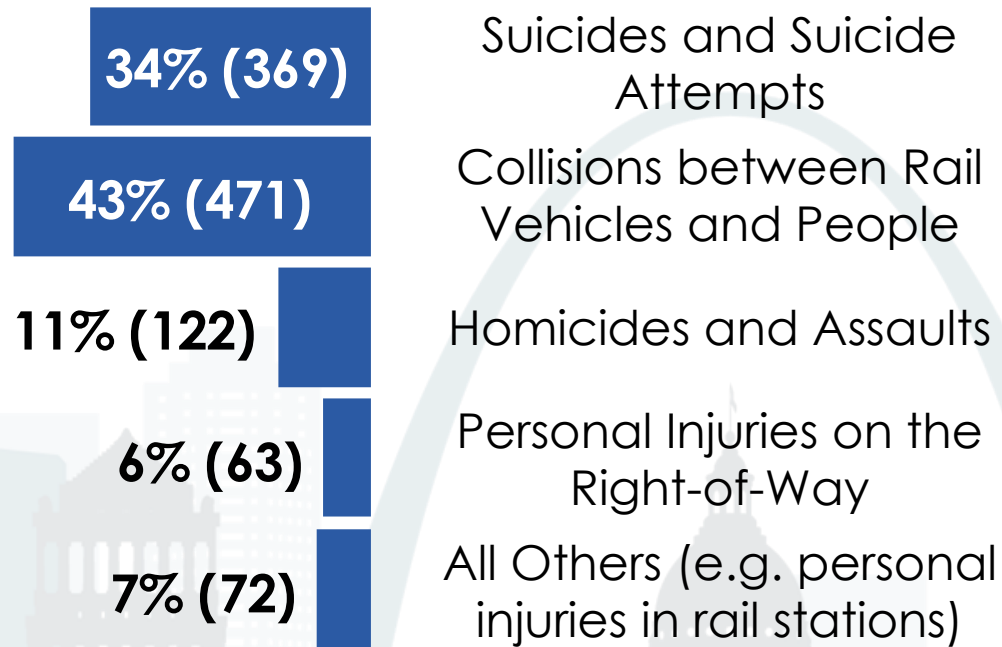

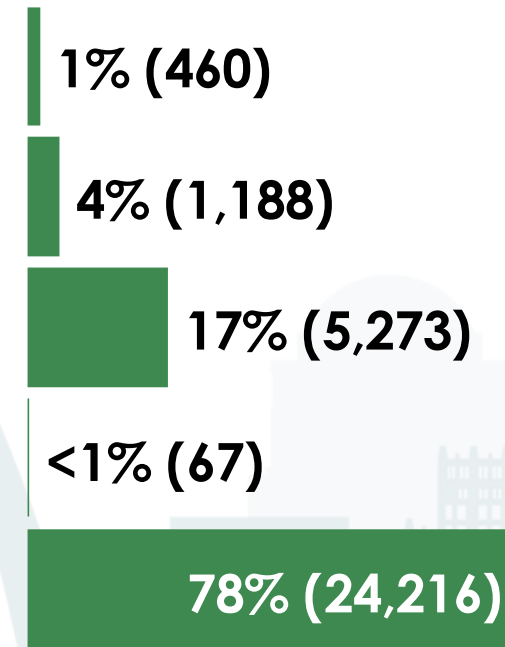
