

State of Rail Transit Safety – Annual Trends



Sources of Rail Transit Fatalities and Injuries


Rail Transit Fatalities and Injuries by Source, Oct 2017–Aug 2023

State of Bus Transit Safety – Annual Trends



Bus-to-Person Collisions: The Data



From 2008 to 2021, transit agencies reported **7,298 busto-person collisions** to the National Transit Database, which resulted in **537 fatalities** and **7,329 injuries**

Bus-to-Person collisions accounted for:


Of Bus-Transit Fatalities

Safety Advisory 23-1

- Published on September 19, 2023
- Recommends transit agencies that provide bus service:
 - **Identify hazards** that may cause or contribute to bus-to-person collisions and assess the associated safety risk
 - When conducting safety risk assessments, consider bus operator vision impairment




Rail Transit Worker Assault Fatalities and Injuries, Jan 2014–Aug 2023

Regulatory Activity Update (Slide 1 of 2)

Public Transportation Agency Safety Plans (PTASP)

Incorporates new requirements established through the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law.

Anticipated Final Publication: Spring 2024

Comment Period Closed June 26, 2023

Public Transportation Safety Certification Training Program (PTSCP)

Amends training curriculum to reflect new requirements and training course information.

NPRM Published in the Federal Register in October 2023

Comment Period Closed December 26, 2023

Transit Worker
Hours of Service
and Fatigue Risk
Management

Asks questions about establishing minimum standards related to transit worker fitness for duty.

ANPRM Published in the Federal Register in October 2023

Comment Period Closes January 29, 2024

State Safety Oversight (SSO) Update Introduces changes to clarify State Safety Oversight Agencies' (SSOA) oversight responsibilities and authority to conduct inspections.

NPRM Published in the Federal Register in November 2023

Comment Period Closes February 15, 2024



Regulatory Activity Update (Slide 2 of 2)

National Public Transportation Safety Plan (NSP) Proposes additional performance measures, best practices, tools, technical assistance, voluntary standards and other resources.

Anticipated Final Publication: Winter 2024

Rail Transit Roadway
Worker Protection
(RWP)

Establishes minimum baseline standards and risk-based redundant protection requirements. **Anticipated NPRM Publication: Spring 2024**

Transit Worker Public Safety Rule

Establishes minimum baseline standards and risk-based requirements to address transit worker and public safety including but not limited to FAST Act section 3022 requirements. **Anticipated NPRM Publication: Spring 2024**
