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

Rail Transit Roadway	Establishes minimum baseline standards and risk-based redundant protection requirements.	Comment Period
Worker Protection	NPRM Published in the Federal Register: March 25, 2024	Closes
(RWP)	Anticipated Final Publication: Fall 2024	May 24, 2024
National Public Transportation Safety Plan (NSP)	Proposes additional performance measures, best practices, tools, technical assistance, voluntary standards and other resources. Anticipated Final Publication: Spring 2024	Comment Period Closed July 31, 2023
Public Transportation	Incorporates new requirements established through the Bipartisan	Comment Period
Agency Safety	Infrastructure Law.	Closed
Plans (PTASP)	Anticipated Final Publication: Spring 2024	June 26, 2023
Public Transportation Safety Certification Training Program (PTSCTP)	Amends training curriculum to reflect new requirements and training course information. NPRM Published in the Federal Register: October 2023 Anticipated Final Publication: Spring 2024	Comment Period Closed December 26, 2023

State Safety Oversight (SSO) Update	Introduces changes to clarify State Safety Oversight Agencies' (SSOA) oversight responsibilities and authority to conduct inspections. NPRM Published in the Federal Register in November 2023 Anticipated Final Publication: Summer 2024	Comment Period Closed February 15, 2024
Transit Worker Public Safety Rule	Establishes minimum baseline standards and risk-based requirements to address transit worker and public safety including but not limited to Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) section 3022 requirements. Anticipated NPRM Publication: Winter 2024	Comment Period Opens Winter 2024
Transit Worker Hours of Service and Fatigue Risk Management	Asks questions about establishing minimum standards related to transit worker fitness for duty. ANPRM Published in the Federal Register: October 2023	Comment Period Closed January 29, 2024



#### **Assaults on Transit Workers General Directive**

FTA published a proposed General Directive for notice and comment on December 20, 2023, and the comment period closed on February 20, 2024. FTA received 63 comment submissions with 230 individual comments.

#### **General Directive Requirements:**

Conduct Safety Risk Assessment (SRA) for assaults on transit workers: Within 60 days of issuance of GD, unless agency has conducted within past 12 months

Identify safety risk mitigations: RTAs serving a large urbanized area must involve the joint labormanagement Safety Committee when identifying safety risk mitigations

Submit information to FTA: RTAs must submit information on how they are assessing, mitigating, and monitoring the safety risk associated with assaults on transit workers



#### **FTA Enhanced Transit Safety and Crime Prevention Initiative**

Provides information and resources to help transit agencies protect transit workers and riders, including:

- Federal funding eligibilities to improve • safety
- Training courses offered by the National . Transit Institute (NTI), like Assault Awareness and Prevention for Transit **Operators and Violence in the Transit** Workplace

#### Overview

Transit worker and rider safety is a top priority for the Biden-Harris Administration and the U.S. Department of Transportation. Public transit is a safe form of transportation. Transit workers should expect a safe workplace and riders should expect a safe trip.
