

Review and Selection Process

- Technical evaluation review teams (Federal staff) will evaluate proposals based on the published evaluation criteria identified in the NOFO and provide technical recommendations to leadership
- FTA may also consider the extent to which applications promote key priorities of Executive Order 13990, which aims to:
 - $\,\circ\,$ Promote clean energy, conservation, and environmental justice
 - Emphasize scientific integrity and evidence-based decision making
 - $\,\circ\,$ Mitigate climate change and prioritize environmental sustainability
- FTA may consider geographic diversity, diversity in recipient type/size, and cap the amount a single applicant may receive



APPLICANT REGISTRATION

Organizations Must Register with SAM.gov and Grants.gov

SAM.gov

The System for Award Management (SAM.gov) is a government-wide registry for organizations doing business with the Federal government. SAM.gov centralizes information about grant recipients and provides a central location for grant recipients to change organizational information. Grants.gov uses SAM.gov to establish organizational authority for its users and to provide unique entity identification numbers. SAM registration must be renewed annually.

Applicants must register their

organization in Grants.gov to

submit applications

First, you must register with SAM.gov to obtain a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI). The UEI is a 12-character alphanumeric identifier assigned to all entities (public and private companies, individuals, institutions, or organizations) to do business with the Federal Government. Organizations will also need to designate an E-Business Point of Contact (EBiz POC). It can take 7-10 business days to fully complete the registration process required for most funding opportunities. There is no fee for registering with SAM.gov.

Grants.gov

After obtaining the UEI for the organization from SAM.gov, you must return to Grants.gov to continue registration. There is no fee for registering with Grants.gov. Your organization's EBiz POC must: 1. Create a Grants.gov account with the same email address as used in SAM.gov for EBiz POC, and 2. Add a profile with Grants.gov using the UEI obtained from SAM.gov.

The EBiz POC can then delegate administrative roles to other users. Read the Help article, Manage Roles for


