# Defining T2

- **FTA defines Technology Transfer** as the exchange of information to enable the deployment, adoption, and potentially the commercialization of FTA-funded research findings.
- **FTA tracks technology research** projects along the lifecycle of the projects and notes whether the recipient conducting the research chooses to adopt the new technology or process.
- **FTA analyzes data** from the internal database of all FTA-funded programs using natural language search techniques to assess the level of deployment of FTA researched solutions.
- **FTA can reach a wider audience** in the transit industry and more effectively track the use of FTA research findings.

# Why is T2 Important for Public Transportation?

- FTA engages in research to provide the transit industry and policy makers with the information and skills to make good business decisions about transit technology, operations, and capital investments.
- Over \$200 million a year in projects are managed across many subject areas.
- As many as 15 to 20 reports are published on a yearly basis.
- The research results that are published have deployment opportunity.

# T2 Program Goals

1. Develop processes, systems, and resources to support the deployment and adoption of FTA's innovative research results in the public transportation industry.
2. Support the commercialization and production of technologies developed in the U.S., in part through FTA-funded research and development.
3. Overcome barriers and challenges affecting the adoption of research products in transit agencies.



# T2 Program Components

- Promote the early deployment of innovative research.
- Advance promising technologies, practices and strategies. including, but not limited to planning, acquiring essential services, and program implementation.
- Promote activities that seek to commercialize technologies developed through FTA funding.
- Explore solutions to facilitate change management in the use of promising FTA innovative research adoption.

# Overview: T2 Program Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO)

- **Eligible Applicants:**
  - Departments, agencies, and instrumentalities of local, state, Tribal and federal government, including Federal laboratories;
  - Institutions of higher education, including research universities;
  - Non-profit organizations;
  - For-profit organizations;
  - Technical and community colleges.
- **\$5M total available:** FTA's Public Transportation Innovation program funds this new program (49 § U.S.C. 5312).
- Applications are due **February 11, 2025.**

# Overview: T2 Program NOFO

- FTA will award one four-year cooperative agreement for \$5 million, with the possibility for an extension of up to two years depending upon performance.
- Eligible activities: deploying, supporting, and documenting of the practices, performance, and benefits of T2.

# Key Dates and Application Submission

- FTA released T2 NOFO on Tuesday, December 3, 2024.
- Submit Applications by February 11, 2025, by 11:59 PM EDT through Grants.gov.
- Applications must include:
  - SF-424 Application for Federal Assistance;
  - Supplemental Form;
  - Proposal.
- Other supporting documents may include letters of support, MOUs, and technical information, as necessary.

# Overall Review and Selection Process

- **Evaluate**: Technical evaluation committee made up of Federal staff will evaluate applications based on the evaluation criteria:
  - Organizational Capacity and Key Personnel Experience;
  - Proposer and Proposal Team Technical Expertise;
  - Applied Research and Other Related Experience;
  - Proposed Partnerships;
  - Project Approach and Work Plan;
  - Technical, Legal, and Financial Capacity.

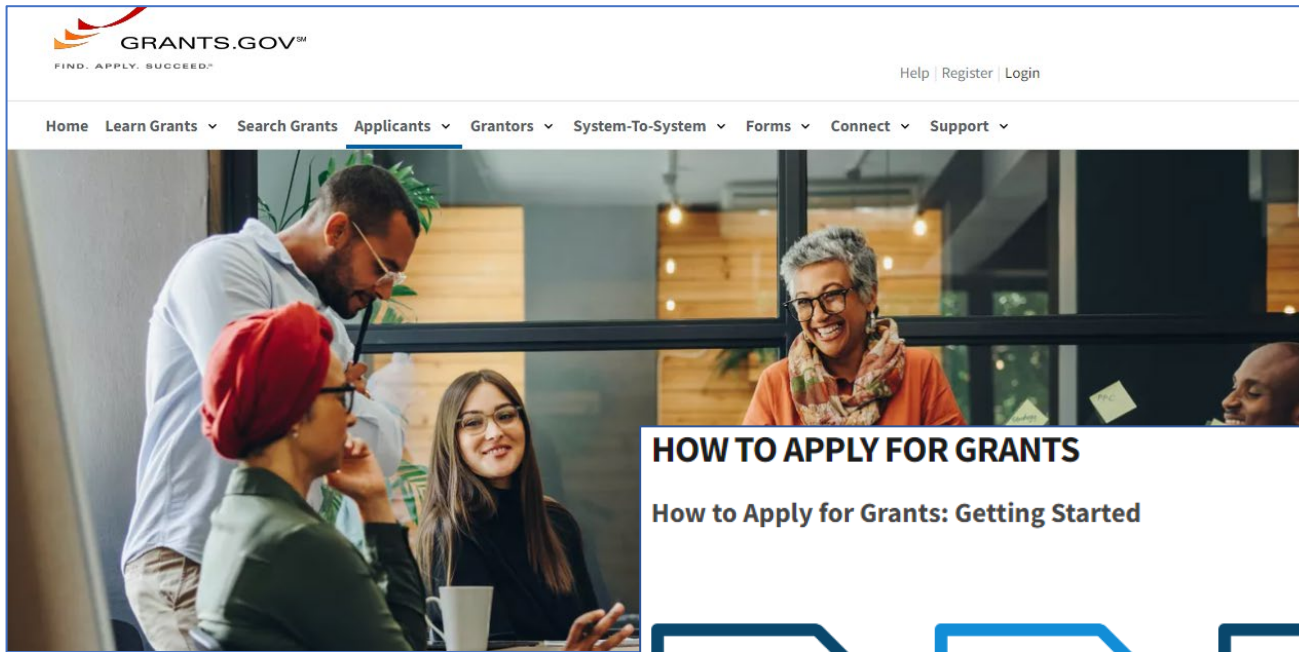





### Get Started on Your Workspace Application

Workspace is the standard way for organizations or individuals to apply for federal grants in Grants.gov. Workspace allows a grant team to simultaneously access and edit different forms within an application. Plus, the forms can be filled out online or offline – your choice.

Grants.gov Workspace also allows applicants and organizations to choose which approach to use for their application workflow. Here are three approaches that applicants can take when completing a Workspace application:

Basic	Intermediate	Advanced


