Dear Mr. Brams:

Pursuant to New Jersey Transit's (NJT) request for another extension, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) is willing to grant a third and final extension to NJT to allow it to respond to FTA's Notification of Outstanding Debt and Demand for Payment letter (the "Demand"). FTA agrees NJT shall have sixty (60) calendar days from NJT's receipt of the Demand. In your meeting with the Federal Government on January 11, 2011, you indicated that NJT received the Demand on November 26, 2010, so the response is due no later than January 25, 2011. Under FTA's Debt Collection Order, FTA O 2060.1A, FTA cannot allow any further extensions beyond the sixty (60) days.
