
A Brief History

- ❖ Boston Express Bus, a New Hampshire company, was incorporated in 2006
- ❖ The company represents a partnership between the Principals of Concord Coach Lines and C&J; bringing a combined 80 years of experience in the bus industry
- ❖ Together the two owners operated three intercity bus operations before jointly forming Boston Express
- ❖ Boston Express, was contracted to provide intercity passenger transportation services to Southern New Hampshire by the NH Department of Transportation



Route Map

- Service along Route 3 from Nashua into Boston and Logan Airport began in February of 2007.
- ❖ I-93 service began in mid-November of 2008 to mitigate traffic congestion along the I-93 corridor during the widening project.

Nashua Service

- Boston Express was formed to provide quality passenger bus service from the State's second largest city into Boston and Logan Airport, in accordance with a NHDOT RFP.
- Service began in February of 2007 from the northern tier of Nashua at Exits 6 and 8, at existing State facilities. In the Summer of 2008, Exit 8 became a full service agency, selling tickets from a trailer in the park and ride.

When service commenced it required 6 buses, and operated 9 round trips daily.

The total investment for the Nashua service was \$3.68 million, including the purchasing of buses.








Nashua 2008 Expenses


- ❖ Transportation Expense, consisting mainly of drivers' wages and fuel costs made up more than 50% of the expenses.
- ❖ Expenses were only up from \$1.2 million to \$1.5 million despite operating an additional month and adding a full service terminal.




Total 2008 Expenses \$1,501,226

2007 to 2008 Expenses were up 21.3%. Paling in comparison to the 56.1% growth in operating revenue.




2008 Revenue vs. Expense



Nashua Passenger Numbers



I-93 Service

- ❖ Boston Express bid on a NHDOT RFP to reduce traffic congestion on the interstate during and after the widening project.
- ❖ Boston Express service along the I-93 commenced on November 17th of 2008.
- * Buses stop in Center City
 Manchester, North and South
 Londonderry, as well as Salem, en route to
 Boston.
- ❖ Building off the previously established terminal in South Londonderry, BX has been well received in the market.
- The Downtown Manchester terminal is slated for refurbishing by the end of 2009




1–93 Operating Subsidy

Over the course of a three year contract, only 4.4 million will go towards operating subsidy—including a marketing budget.

❖ The 3.8 million in operating money will help to close the gap between expenses and revenue in the first 3 years of the contract.






1–93 Capital Investment

The state of New Hampshire's Capital Contribution totaled \$29,850,000


❖ This consisted of the construction of two brand new terminals off of I-93 as well as a Maintenance Garage for the buses



I–93 Passenger Counts

Despite starting service amidst an economic downturn and a drop-off in leisure travel, the I-93 service is carrying in upwards of 20,000 passengers a month.

- ❖ I-93 passenger numbers continue to grow every month.
- ❖ 13% from February to March and continuing into April, though the numbers are incomplete.

The Environmental Benefits of BX

Getting people out of their cars reduces traffic congestion and pollution. These are the projected savings for Boston Express in 2009 along I-93


- ❖ 300,000 fewer cars on the road between Manchester and Boston.
- ❖ 7.35 million pounds worth of emissions saved.
- \$1.65 million dollars saved on fuel by people opting to take the bus.
- ❖ Fewer cars, means safer roads, and a better environment.




Challenges Ahead

- Opening a new passenger terminal at the Exit 8 location in Nashua, slated to begin construction and completion by the end of summer 2010.
- Once Exit 8 is complete, the next objective is to move out of the Welcome Center off Exit 6 into a small facility in Tyngsborough, MA to better appeal to the market in Southern Nashua.
- ❖ Develop a full-fare business in both Nashua and on I-93 to continue to close the gap between expenses and sales.
- ❖ Streamlining the I-93 schedule to meet the needs of Logan Airport passengers, as well as our emerging commuter market in Salem.
- ❖ Accomplishing a self-sufficient Nashua system by February 2010, when the operating subsidy ends.
