New York Alliance for Transport/Logistics Advancement Services is a three-year, \$1.4 MM J.P. Morgan Chase Foundation funded initiative connecting youth workers with careers in public and private transport. Our career pathways are offered in a variety trainings, these include a NYS Department of Labor registered Diesel mechanic apprenticeship, an auto-technician training, and Commercial Driver's License training and certification.



NYMAP

The New York Mechanic's Apprenticeship Program was founded in partnership with the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers (IAMAW) to address a lack of incoming mechanics and related titles. This three-year apprenticeship brings trainees to journey-worker status. *All apprentices earn college credit from Bronx Community College, CUNY for related instruction.*

- ⚙️ **Second track to prepare students with NYCTA bus specific curricula**
- ⚙️ MTA test prep, TLC TC-3 Public Transit curricula and testing fees funding

Regional suburban lines and private contractors for Board of Education and para-transit companies are in dire need of the next generation of skilled mechanics.
